Dr Supriya Phadnis is a public health expert with more than 9 years of experience of working with governmental, non-governmental and academic organizations. Supriya has completed her Masters of Public Health degree from the School of Health Sciences, Savitribai Phule Pune University (formerly known as University of Pune) in 2008. Supriya's work explores the health issues of families of patients affected with birth defects and disabilities especially in resource limited settings.
