Supriya's work explores the health issues of families of patients affected with birth defects and disabilities especially in resource limited settings. She uses scalebased parameters such as Health related Quality of Life and Quality of life to document the impact of lifelong conditions on physical, mental and social interactions of affected families. She has developed an educational and psychosocial support documentary especially for parents of children affected with Haemophilia, a rare bleeding disorder. Her research also encompasses the economic aspects of chronic disabling conditions. Her areas of Defects Management, interest are Birth Healthcare Structure and Health Policy and Planning.
