WHY

THIS PROGRAMME

During the Covid crisis, remote work, telework, or working from home became the norm rather than the exception, disrupting the way work was ever imagined. While some IT organisations have strategies in place for WFH and managing global, remote talent, this shift was unique for many other industry leaders. As a result, they had to learn new abilities for managing remote workers. The new team structure requires awareness of the obstacles that an employee working remotely, frequently from home or a shared workspace, faces, as well as leadership style variations that are often subtle but significant in the virtual environment. Along with it, there are modern techniques of human resource anchors that allow for seamless work by distant personnel.

This three-day offline workshop is meant to help managers and leaders understand how to manage themselves, others, and remote staff in the absence of non-verbal and verbal indicators by using virtual empathy.

PEDAGOGY

The workshop will take place at our Goa Campus. Prof Anamika will be the program's anchor. The sessions will include psychometric exams, offline online and simulations. lectures, case studies, and recorded practices from best industry professionals as pre-workshop-work. Experts from the industry will also be explain the present to genuine subtleties of dealing with remote work.
