CALL FOR PAPERS (FOR CONFERENCE/JOURNAL)

The post-COVID-19 pandemic period has posed many challenges and uncertainty to for global growth. One key challenge is the growing energy insecurity and the implication it is having on not only macroeconomic stability and economic growth but on geopolitical relevance of bilateral and multilateral partnerships. Goal 7 of the United Nations SDGs emphasizes on having access to affordable, reliable, sustainable and modern energy for all. Consistent with this goal, the theme of the conference is: “Energy Insecurity: accessibility, affordability and sustainability”. The conference welcomes papers (letter type papers with maximum of 2,500 words,) both empirical and policy oriented, that address any one or a combination of the following sub-themes:

- Sustainable energy economics
- Sustainable energy consumption
- Economic growth and energy consumption
- Energy modelling
- Energy demand and pricing
- Green energy and energy storage
- Energy finance
- Energy policy and energy market forecasting

- Renewable energy and growth challenges during post COVID-19 recovery
- Energy poverty, environmental effects and sustainability
- Financing of the green energy sector

SUBMISSION PROCEDURE

All research papers meant for conference need to be submitted to the Energy Research Letters (Scopus-indexed Journal) on (<https://erl.scholasticahq.com/for-authors>) and a copy to chinmaya@gim.ac.in or badrirath@gmail.com .

REGISTRATION FEE AND ACCOMODATION

There is no registration fee for the conference. Your travel cost will be paid by the host organisations (3AC train fare or maximum of INR 3000). Free accommodation will be provided on the GIM campus on a sharing basis. The presenting author (one author per paper) can only avail all these facilities. The other co-authors or any accompanying person needs to arrange their own travel, accommodation, local transport, food, etc., at their own cost.

GUIDELINES AND PUBLICATION OPPORTUNITY

- **Word limit:** Maximum 2,500 words. Each paper can only have a maximum of 4 tables/figures combined. In preparing your manuscripts, follow recent papers published in Energy Research Letters.
- All invited paper will be presented at the parallel sessions and each paper will have an assigned discussant. Each paper will have 20 minutes to present his/her; a discussant will discuss the paper for 7 minutes; and 3 minutes will be allocated for additional question and answers.
- All presented papers in the conference will be considered for publication in the Scopus indexed journal conditional on the paper passing the editorial review process of the said journal.
